Requirements:

1. Youth eligible to exhibit in this department are those enrolled in a 4-H Cloverbuds project or other youth groups carrying a similar program as their supervised project.
2. Entries must be made by the youth member (with adult or youth leader supervision). The Cloverbuds should be able to explain their exhibit to the face-to-face judge.
3. Cloverbud exhibits are judged from 1:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Thursday.
4. Each member may enter up to three (3) different items. Enter only one item from each Lot Number listed below.
5. A participation ribbon, a premium of \$1.50, and a coupon for an ice cream treat from the 4-H Foodstand will be awarded to each Cloverbud exhibitor
4. Posters must be 14" X 22" and scrapbooks 8½" x 11" or 12" x 12".
5. No live animals may be exhibited in the Cloverbud department.
6. Display trays will be provided. Food is not returned to the exhibitor.
7. Cloverbud entries may be removed after 8:00 p.m. on Sunday.
