

Department 415 - Flowers And Houseplants

Requirements:

1. Wildflowers may not be used in bouquets or arrangements. Wild greens may be used.
2. This department is open to amateurs only. Each exhibitor must create his or her own arrangement.
3. Cut flower exhibits must be 3 stems or blooms unless specified, exhibited in a narrow-necked, clear glass container.
4. Houseplant exhibits must include a 3 X 5 inch card labeled with the name of plant and date started.
5. All plants and plant products must be the property of the exhibitor and the result of the exhibitor's own efforts.
