1. Honey must be the product of bees owned by the exhibitor.
2. Maple syrup must be from the current season's crop
3. Maple syrup must be in a certified glass container.
3. Honey and syrup entries may be opened by the judge.

CLASS B--EVERGREENS - CHRISTMAS TREES

Requirements:

1. Trees must have been grown in Oconto County.
2. Trees must be freshly cut.
3. Trees will be judged based on USDA Christmas Tree Grades.
4. Trees must be exhibited standing in a pail of moist sand or sand/moss mixture furnished by the exhibitor.
5. All trees must be between 5 feet and 8 feet tall, measured from the tip of the leader to the bottom of the handle. A trimmed handle shall be no less than 6 inches long or more than 1 3/4 inches for each foot of tree.
6. Artificially colored trees will be disqualified.
7. Exhibitors may enter as many classes as they wish but no more than one tree per class.
